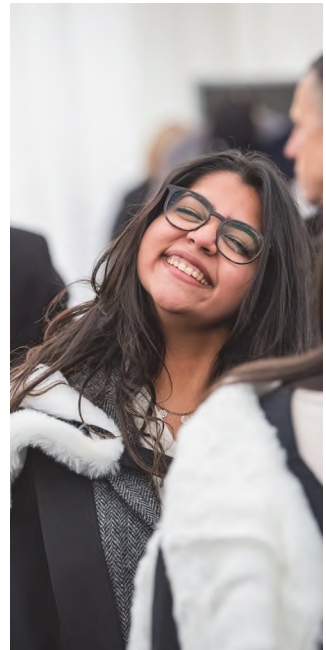
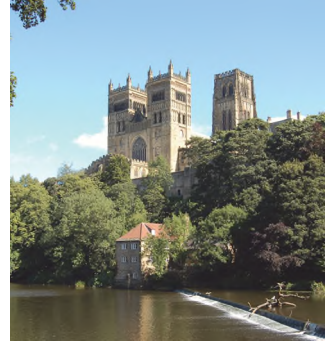

Graduate Outcomes (GO) ⁷ Survey

What is the GO Survey?

- A survey to determine what graduates are doing 15 months after completing their course

How will the GO Survey be conducted?

- You will be emailed a link to complete the GO Survey online. If you do not complete it online, you will receive a telephone call to ask for your response.

Why is the GO Survey important?

- Knowing where our graduates are working and studying helps inform the career planning of our students and graduates
- Remember using Unistats when applying to university? It's this anonymised data! Help future applicants, like previous graduates helped you.

How you can help us?

- Complete your GO Survey fully in a timely manner

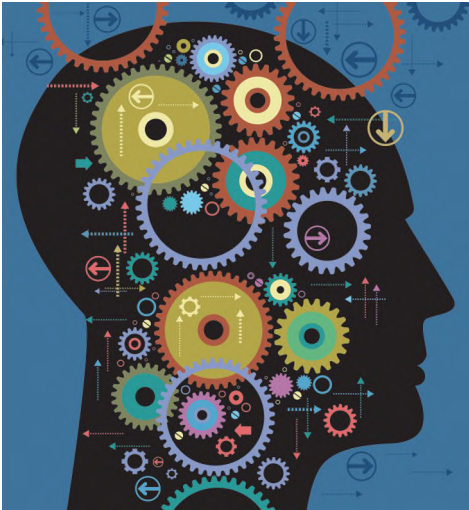
