

**Postgraduate Offer Holder Online Q&A sessions –
Alumni Ambassadors**

We are offering an exciting opportunity for Durham Alumni to be involved in our Postgraduate Conversion strategy.

We are holding a series of Question-and-Answer sessions for our Offer Holders throughout the months of July, August and September and invite you to be a guest panelist on these webinars. You will be joined by another Durham graduate and two other current postgraduate students from your faculty area. Each session will be hosted and moderated by a staff member for the central recruitment team. The Offer Holder sessions are all online and you will provide attendees with advice and guidance about relative study and career options, drawing from your own experiences.

We are allocating ambassadors to the sessions by faculty, not including the Business School, to keep them targeted and the questions relevant for both the student audience and the panel.

Role expectations:

Offer Holder online Q&A sessions – contribute as part of an online session with other Alumni Ambassadors, current Postgraduate ambassadors, and university staff to talk about why you chose Durham and your journey from postgraduate study to employment, answering questions from prospective students logging in from around the world.

Role criteria:

- Have completed a postgraduate course at Durham.
- Have studied at Durham in the Faculty of Science, Social Sciences and Health or Arts and Humanities.
- Be available online using the Zoom webinar platform for one hour using video and microphone.
- Be available to set up and log on from 15 minutes before your designated session begins.
- Provide an overview of your journey from Durham and what you do now.
- Present yourself with a friendly, positive attitude.
- Be able to confidently answer questions relating to postgraduate study at Durham and where it can lead for job prospects.
- Be open and honest about your experiences and speak with enthusiasm about opportunities and futures from Durham University.

A full event briefing will be provided ahead of the online sessions, and you will have support from staff in the Recruitment and Admissions Team throughout.
